

General terms and conditions

Definitions

Foundation Humanized Tech Awards Europe: organiser of the event the Humanized Tech Awards, also a trade name of the Humanized Tech Foundation Awards., established in Almere, registered in the Trade Register of the Chamber of Commerce of the Netherlands under number 73492574 .

The event: the event to hold the Humanized Tech Awards in 2020 in Den Bosch. An evening in which awards are presented by the professional jury of judges.

The award(s): a symbolic and honorable recognition of the technology of the participant in his field of expertise by means of a trophy awarded by the professional jury.

The participation: the submission of a nomination, which will allow the technology of a participant to be judged by the professional jury and compete for the award.

The participant(s): the person whose technology has been submitted (possibly by himself) and whose participation has been confirmed by the Humanized Tech Awards, which thus qualifies as an agreement between the parties.

The submission(s): the submission of a case that meets the requirements as set out in the application form.

The professional jury: a panel of professional individuals who, on the basis of the entries, will be invited to participate in a making a shortlist of nominees, which will be announced on 30 December 2020 and then the winners will be announced at the event .

Conditions for submission

1. The event's Humanized Tech Awards will be held in February or March 2020.
2. Entries may be submitted until 1 December 2019.
3. Entries shall be accepted only if they are accompanied by the following information, which is intended for that purpose. The questionnaire form has been used and participation has been confirmed. If you do not receive this confirmation by immediately, please contact us.
4. Incomplete forms will not be considered.
5. Once the participation of the entry has been confirmed, the entry will be rejected by the The jury of experts will be judged and will be able to do so for the sake of honesty and transparency.
6. The members of the professional jury and their related companies are excluded from adjudication on the case in which they have cooperated or are in the process of doing so connected. The professional jury tries in its performance independence and ensure impartiality and shall not be called into question during the assessment or (written) consultation with the participants regarding the content of the entry.
7. After submission, it is no longer possible to cancel the participation.

8. Entries must be a maximum of two pages with a minimum font size of 10.

Files that are attached for support and illustration may be up to 5MB per file with a limit of 20MB. These files must also be free of any virus or malware under penalty of forfeiture. of a fine of €500.00, which does not detract from the fact that the Humanized Tech Awards the actual damage suffered by the participant in question will be payable by applicant.

9. The Humanized Tech Awards reserves the right to change parts of its products or services. in the categories of the awards, if the number of entries for each item is less than three entries. It also reserves the right to change the time limit for the extent of the participation, if in the opinion of the organisation there is reason to do so. The Humanized Tech Awards reserves the right to change the titles of or shorten or change entries for publication, announcement, etc, if in its opinion they are not concise enough.

11. By submitting an entry, the participant grants the Humanized Tech Awards the right to to include its name and/or company logo on the website <https://humanizedtechawards.com/> (to mention the participants), as well as (parts of) the entry on this website, and during the event to illustrate the reason for nomination. Matters of which the participants are explicitly aware at the time of submission given that they are not intended for publication and are thus marked, will never be made public without written permission.

12. Submissions may also be used by the Humanized Tech Awards for the following purposes:

- Submitted for the promotion and marketing purposes of the event. Supporting material for the entries will be provided at the latest one year after the event will be destroyed.
